



Work Based Learning Experiences

Ready to start thinking about your career and your future? Seminole County Public Schools is offering our 2023 SCPS Work Based Learning Experiences (WBLE) for students with disabilities!

WHO

Students ages 14-21 who are currently: enrolled in school, have an IEP/504 and are a client of Vocational Rehabilitation (VR) or VR Pre-ETS may participate in this program.

Not a client of VR, that's ok we can help connect you with VR.

WHAT

20 hours work experiences are offered in the community at a local business site.

Flexible scheduling and dates available; WBLEs can be during the day and on weekends.

Your Transition Resource Teacher will reach out to you to plan times and location of the worksite.

This training provides practical exposure to different careers and hands-on training for employability skills at local businesses in Seminole County with a trained job coach. These experiences focus on practicing social skills and building relationships.

Students must provide their own transportation to and from the worksite.
